The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), which is now known as Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (GOI) has established the National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent, autonomous, and self-sustained premier testing organization under the Societies Registration Act (1860) for conducting efficient, transparent and international standards tests in order to assess the competency of candidates for admissions to premier higher education institutions.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been designated for conducting National Teachers Eligibility Test (NTET) since 2024, on behalf of Ministry of AYUSH/NCISM/NCH with the approval of the Ministry of Education.

2. About National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH)

The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine is the statutory body constituted under NCISM Act, 2020 (No. 14 of 2020) vide Gazette notification extraordinary Part (ii) Section 1 dated 21.09.2020.

An Act to provide for a medical education system that improves access to quality and affordable medical education, ensures availability of adequate and high quality medical professionals of Indian System of Medicine in all parts of the country; that promotes equitable and universal healthcare that encourages community health perspective and makes services of such medical professionals accessible and affordable to all the citizens; that promotes national health goals; that encourages such medical professionals to adopt latest medical research in their work and to contribute to research; that has an objective periodic and transparent assessment of medical institutions and facilitates maintenance of a medical register of Indian System of Medicine for India and enforces high ethical standards in all aspects of medical services; that is flexible to adapt to the changing needs and has an effective grievance redressal mechanism and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

Conduction of National Teachers' Eligibility Test for the postgraduates of each discipline of the Indian System of Medicine (Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha) who desire to take up teaching profession in that discipline is governed under NCISM Act 2020 (Ref. Section 17of NCISM Act 2020) and National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (National Examinations for Indian System of Medicine) Regulations, 2023.

About National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH)

The National Commission for Homoeopathy is the statutory body constituted under NCH Act, 2020 (No. 15 of 2020) vide Gazette notification extraordinary Part (ii) Section 1 dated 21.09.2020.

An Act to provide for a medical education system that improves access to quality and affordable medical education, ensures availability of adequate and high quality Homoeopathy medical professionals in all parts of the country; that promotes equitable and universal healthcare that encourages community health perspective and makes

services of Homoeopathy medical professionals accessible and affordable to all the citizens; that promotes national health goals; that encourages Homoeopathy medical professionals to adopt latest medical research in their work and to contribute to research; that has an objective periodic and transparent assessment of medical institutions and facilitates maintenance of a Homoeopathy medical register for India and enforces high ethical standards in all aspects of medical services; that is flexible to adapt to the changing needs and has an effective grievance redressal mechanism and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

Conduction of National Teachers' Eligibility Test for the postgraduates of Homoeopathy who desire to take up teaching profession in that discipline is governed under NCH Act 2020 (Ref. Section 14 of NCH Act 2020) and National Commission for Homoeopathy (National Examinations for Homoeopathy) Regulations, 2023.

3. National Teachers Eligibility Test (NTET)-2024

- (1) The National Teachers' Eligibility Test for each discipline of Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani of Indian Systems of Medicine & Homoeopathy shall be conducted by the Commission for the postgraduates of each discipline of Indian system of medicine & Homoeopathy who desire to take up teaching profession.
- (2) The Teachers' eligibility shall be valid for a period of ten years from the date of qualifying National Teachers' Eligibility Test for Indian System of Medicine/ Homoeopathy and any person fails to join within a period of ten years or break of ten years or more in teaching profession, such persons shall have to qualify once again National Teachers' Eligibility Test for Indian System of Medicine/ Homoeopathy to join or re-join teaching profession.
- (3) The National Teachers' Eligibility test is to assess teaching aptitude; communication skills; classroom management; teaching, training and assessment technology; student psychology; andragogy; pedagogy or such other as may be specified by the Commissions from time to time.
- (6) The minimum eligibility criteria for appearing National Teachers' Eligibility Test for Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy shall be a post-graduate degree holder in a discipline recognized by the Commissions or erstwhile Central Council for Indian System of Medicine/ Central council of Homoeopathy
- (7) A candidate secured minimum of fifty percent and above shall be declared as qualified in National Teachers' Eligibility Test for Indian System of Medicine/ Homoeopathy.
- (8) The qualified candidates shall be issued 'NTET Certificate' certificate by the respective Commission

- 5.3 The Post-Graduate degree students in Indian System of Medicine <u>completed</u> thirty months of Post-graduate Degree program shall be eligible to appear in this examination whereas for homoeopathic system of Medicine the candidate with recognized Post-Graduate degree shall be eligible to appear in this examination.
- 5.4 Any person having requisite qualifications and age for teacher who is working or has worked in non-teaching profession such as medical officers, research officers and desire to take up teaching profession, shall have to qualify the National Teachers' Eligibility Test for Indian System of Medicine.
- 5.5 Any person who desires to take up teaching profession for the first time as Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor in Indian System of Medicine who is possessing the requisite age and qualifications as specified in the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022; the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2022; the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2022.

Homoeopathy

- 5.6 Any person who desires to take up teaching profession at the level of Assistant professor for the first time shall have to appear for this examination and shall have to obtain minimum of fifty percent. (without round off) of marks to get qualified.
- 5.7 Master of Science in Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Master of Public Health from recognised Institutes can also appear for National Teacher's Eligibility Test examination for the post of Assistant Professor, if the candidates are holding the Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery degree.
- 5.8 Any person who desires to take up teaching profession at the level of Associate professor for the first time and having five years of experience in regular service (after possessing post-graduate qualification in the concerned subject) in Central Government Health Services or State Government Health services, Ministry of Ayush or full time five years of experience as medical officer in regular service (after possessing postgraduate qualification in the concerned subject) in recognised Homoeopathy Medical College can appear in National Teacher's Eligibility Test examination for the post of Associate Professor.
- 5.9 Any person who desires to take up teaching profession at the level of Associate professor for the first time and having recognised Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy in concerned subject with five years of fulltime research experience in Research Councils of Central Government or State Government or Union territory Administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publication in indexed or peer reviewed journal can appear in National Teacher's Eligibility Test examination for the post of Associate Professor.
- 5.10 Doctor of Philosophy degree holder along with Master of Science in Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology and Master of Public Health from recognised Institutes can appear in National Teacher's Eligibility Test examination for the post of Assistant Professor.

6. Qualifying Percentage:

A candidate secured minimum of <u>fifty percent</u> and above shall be declared as qualified in National Teachers' Eligibility Test for Indian System of Medicine/ Homoeopathy.

7. Facilities for PwD candidates to appear in the exam

7.1 Guidelines for conducting written examination for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities above 40% vide letter dated 29 August 2018 from Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment

Provisions relating to Persons with Disability (PwD):

As per Section 2(t) of the RPwD Act, "Persons with Disability (PwD)" means a person with long-term physical, mental, intellectual, or sensory impairment which, in interaction with barriers, hinders his full and effective participation in society equally with others.

According to Section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016, "persons with benchmark disabilities" means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority.

Facilities for PwD candidates to appear in the exam

As per the guidelines issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment issued from time to time on the subject: "Written Examination for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities", for the candidate with one of the benchmark disabilities [as defined in Section 2(r) of RPwD Act, 2016], holding a Disability Certificate in the prescribed format in the Rights of Person with Disabilities Rules, 2017 (link: https://upload.indiacode.nic.in/showfile?actid=AC CEN 25 54 00002 201649 1517 807328299&type=rule&filename=Rules notified 15.06.pdf).

- a. The facility of Scribe, in case he/she has a physical limitation and a scribe is essential to write the examination on his/her behalf, being so certified in the aforesaid format by a CMO/Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution.
- b. Compensatory time of **one hour** for examination of **three hours** duration, whether such candidate uses the facility of Scribe or not.

SERVICES OF A SCRIBE

As per the office memorandum of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (Reference: F.No. 34-02/2015-DD-III dated August 29, 2018), the PwD candidates who are visually impaired OR have a disability in the upper limbs OR have lost fingers/hands thereby preventing them from properly operating the Computer Based Test platform may avail the services of a scribe (amanuensis).

The scribe will help the Candidate in reading the questions and/or keying in the answers as per the directions of the Candidate. A scribe will NEITHER explain the questions NOR suggest any solutions.

PwD candidates who desire to avail the services of a scribe need to opt for this during the online registration of NTET - 2024.

It is to be noted that the Scribe will be provided by the **National Testing Agency (NTA), if** requested.

If it is found at any stage that a candidate has availed the services of a scribe and/or availed the compensatory time, but does not possess the extent of disability that warrants the use of a scribe and/or grant of compensatory time, the candidate will be excluded from the process of evaluation, ranking, counselling, and admission. In case such a candidate has already been admitted to any Institution, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

Note:

- 1. The minimum degree of disability should be **40%** (**Benchmark Disability**) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability.
- 2. The extent of "specified disability" in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the "Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016)" notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan)] on 4 January 2018.
- No change in the category will be entertained after the last date specified by NTA for NTET – 2024 Registration.

Candidates must note that the benefit of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document, or has furnished false, incorrect, or incomplete information, in order to avail the benefit of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from all admission processes. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

- 7.2 Guidelines for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the said Act, i.e. persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing
- I. These guidelines may be called as Guidelines for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the said Act, i.e. persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing.
- II. The facility of scribe and/or compensatory time shall be granted solely to those having difficulty in writing subject to production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government healthcare

institution as per proforma at Annexure-II.

- III. The medical authority for the purpose of certification as mentioned in point (II) above should be a multi-member authority comprising the following:
 - i. Chief Medical officer/Civil Surgeon/Chief District Medical Officer
 - ii. Orthopaedic/PMR specialist
- iii. Neurologist, if available*
- iv. Clinical Psychologist/Rehabilitation Psychologist/ Psychiatrist/Special Educator
- v. Occupational therapist, if available*
- vi. Any other expert based on the condition of the candidate as may be nominated by the Chairperson. (* the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Chief District Medical Officer may make full efforts for inclusion of neurologists, occupational therapist from the nearest District or the Medical College/Institute, if the same is not available in the District)"
- IV. Compensatory time not less than 20 minutes per hour of the examination should be allowed for persons who are eligible for getting scribe. In case the duration of the examination is less than an hour, then the duration of the compensatory time should be allowed on pro-rata basis. Compensatory time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in the multiple of 5.

8. Choice of Cities for Exam Centre

- 8.1 The City of Examination Centres where the test shall be conducted are given at Annexure-III. It is mandatory for candidates to select Four cities of their choice while filling Online Application Form of NTET 2024. Effort will be made to allot Centre of Examination to the candidates in order of the City Choice opted by them in their Application Form. However, due to administrative/logistic reasons, a different city can be allotted.
- 8.2 In case, there are very few candidates from a City, the NTA reserves the right to merge cities.
- 8.3 The decision of the NTA regarding the allotment of the City/Centre shall be final. No further correspondence or request shall be entertained in such a case.
- 8.4 While filling up the Online Application Form, candidates should select four cities from Appendix III as their Choice of Cities for the Test Centre in order of their priority.
- 8.6 NTA will not be responsible for any inconvenience due to the incorrect selection of cities by the candidates.
- 8.7 Though every effort will be made to allot a Centre in one of the cities selected by the candidate, the NTA reserves the right to allot a Centre in a city other than the

candidate's choice.

8.8 Allotment of Centres will be done mostly in one of the preferred cities of the candidates and there will be no human intervention.

Note: All efforts will be made by NTA to consider the comfort and convenience of candidates, including PwD Candidates while allotting Centres.

9. General Instructions

- 9.1 NTET 2024 is an Examination for Post Graduates of Indian System of Medicine/Homoeopathy and Graduates completed 30 months of PG course the Academic Session 2024-2025.
- 9.2 Merely appearing in NTET 2024 does not make a candidate qualified and eligible for the Certificate.
- 9.3 The last date for submission of the online application for the above exam is as mentioned in the Information at a Glance.
- 9.4 The last date for submission of the application fee online for the above exam is as mentioned in the Information at a Glance.
- 9.5 However, registered candidates can edit their particulars in certain field(s)at the time of correction facility given during the period as notified in the Information at a Glance or through a separate Public Notice to be issued in this regard. No new registrations will be entertained during the correction period.
- 9.6 Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered and candidates may be debarred from appearing in any future examinations conducted by NTA/NCISM/NCH.
- 9.7 Before initiating registration process, candidates should go through the Information Bulletin carefully for eligibility criteria, scheme, and pattern of Examination etc. Any queries and other issues will only be entertained if the requested information is not given in the Information Bulletin.
- 9.8 Incomplete application, if not in accordance with instructions, will not be considered and is liable to be rejected. Applicant should carefully fill up all the fields during registration process correctly. Application cannot be modified/edited, after the closing of correction window period.
- 9.9 The Examination Fee once paid will neither be refunded nor be carried forward under any circumstances.
- 9.10 NTA/NCISM/NCH reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in NTET 2024 even

- though Admit Card/Registration Number has been issued or is displayed on website.
- 9.11 The existing schedule, pattern, policy and guidelines are for ready reference only but in no way, they are or are ought to be treated as representative or acknowledgment of fact that NTA/MoA/NCISM/NCH is bound to follow the same in future.
- 9.12 In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/terms and conditions/ rules/criteria regarding the determination of eligibility/conduct of examinations/ registration of candidates/information contained herein, the interpretation of the NTA/NCISM/NCH will be final and binding.
- 9.13 Requests shall not be entertained for change in date or subject of examination.
- 9.14 Absentees from the Examination will forfeit their Examination fee. No further communication will be acknowledged in this regard.
- 9.15 Result for NTET2024 will be available on the website https://exams.nta.ac.in/NTET/only.
- 9.16 Candidates should ensure before applying for online registration that their degree is recognized as per provisions of erstwhile CCIM/NCISM/CCH/NCH. If it is found at any time that degree is not recognized, the candidature/result of the candidate shall be cancelled.
- 9.17 All the correspondence should be addressed by e-mail. The e-mail query shall be addressed only if it is not anonymous and contains the name, postal address and contact number of the sender. An e-mail containing vague or general queries and other queries as contained in the Information Bulletin shall not be entertained. Queries shall not be entertained from person claiming themselves to be representative, associates or officiates of the applicant candidate.
- 9.18 The following information shall not be revealed by phone or email:
 - a. Internal documentation /status of NTA
 - b. Internal decision-making process of NTA/NCISM/NCH, Any claim/counter claim thereof

- 9.20 NTET2024 will be conducted by NTA at exam centres engaged for the purpose. Candidates are advised to familiarize themselves with the route and location of the exam centre. (Refer to Annexure III for List of Exam cities)
- 9.21 Candidates are advised to look into the website

- https://exams.nta.ac.in/NTET/regularly for various information, updates and notices pertaining to NTET2024 examination.
- 9.22 Kindly note that by registering for the NTET2024, candidates are covered by Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA). As per NDA, candidates cannot disclose any question or contents of question paper in part or otherwise with any person or party or website or such other media/publication. Any act in breach of the NDA shall be liable for penal action as per law. Kindly note that this is a punishable offence and shall lead to cancellation of candidature.
- 9.23 Candidates are deemed to have read, agreed and accepted the contents of Information Bulletin and the terms and conditions in the information bulletin for NTET2024 on completing the registration/Online Application Form by the candidates.
- 9.24 Candidates can register for **NTET 2024 only once**.
- 9.25 Possession/Use of mobile phone or any such electronic devices is strictly prohibited in the premises of NTET2024 Test Centres. Candidates shall be liable for penal action for Possession/ Use of Mobile phones/ Electronic devices.
- 9.26 The jurisdiction for court cases/disputes shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of **competent courts at Delhi/New Delhi only**.

10. Registration and Application Process

Instructions for filling online Application Form

- 10.1 Candidates have to apply for NTET-2024 "Online" ONLY by accessing the website: https://exams.nta.ac.in/NTET/The Application Form other than online mode would not be accepted in any case. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. More than one application i.e. multiple Application Forms submitted by a candidate will be rejected.
- 10.2 It is suggested that the candidate should keep the following ready before starting the filling of the Application Form:
 - A computer with proper internet connectivity
 - The particulars of a valid Government ID proof
 - The Date of Birth (as mentioned in Class X Board Certificate)
 - Govt Identity Details like Aadhaar Number (last 4 digits)/Election Card (EPIC No.)/Passport number/Ration Card Number/ Bank Account Number/PAN Number/ Other valid Govt IDs.
 - Educational/Qualification details
 - Scanned clear passport photograph in JPG/JPEG format (size between 10 kb-200 kb) either in colour or black & white with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background
 - Scanned clear signature in JPG/JPEG format (size between 4 kb–30 kb)

- List of City of your choice (Refer Annexure-III for Cities)
- o Bank account details for payment of fee.
- o A valid e-mail Id as important communications will be made on this e-mail Id
- A valid mobile number as important information via SMS will be sent to this number
- o A valid debit/credit card or Net banking account for ONLINE payment.
- 10.3 Information Bulletin should be downloaded and read carefully by the candidate to be sure about his/her eligibility and acquaint with requirements for submission of Online Application Form.
- 10.4 In order to avoid correction in the particulars in later stage, the candidate should exercise utmost caution before filling up correct details.
- **10.5** Following Steps may be followed to Apply Online:
 - **Step-1:** Apply for Online Registration using own Email Id and Mobile No.
 - Step-2: Fill in the Online Application Form and note down the system generated Application Number.

 Upload scanned images of: (i) the recent photograph (file size 10Kb 200Kb) either in colour or black & white with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background; (ii) candidate's signature (file size: 4kb 30kb).
 - Step-3: Pay fee using Canara Bank/ICICI Bank Payment Gateway through Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card/UPI and keep proof of fee paid.

All the 3 Steps can be done together or at separate timings. The submission of Application of a candidate could be considered as successful and his/her candidature would be confirmed only on the successful transaction/receipt of the prescribed application fee from him/her.

Note:

- (i) The final submission of Online Application Form will remain incomplete if Step-2 and Step 3 are not completed, such Application Forms will stand rejected and no correspondence on this account will be entertained.
- (ii) No request for refund of fee once remitted by the candidate will be entertained.
- (iii) The entire application process of NTET-2024 is online, including uploading of scanned images, Payment of Fees and Printing of Confirmation page. Therefore, candidates are not required to send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation page to NTA through Post/Fax/By Hand/E-mail.
- (iv) Candidates are advised to keep visiting the NTA's website regularly for latest updates and to check their e-mails.
- (V) The NTA/NCISM/NCH can make use of the data generated for the purpose of research and analysis. The data shall not be shared to any other 3rd party.

- list OBC Candidates who are not in OBC-NCL(Central List) must choose General.
- (ii) **Economically Weaker Section (EWS)** -As per the OM No. 20013/01/2019-BC-II dated January 17, 2019 issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the OM No. 12-4/2019-U1 dated 17.01.2019 as well as the Letters No 35-2/2019-T.S.I dated 21.01.2019, 01.02.2019, 04.02.2019 and 15.02.2019 of MHRD Department of Higher Education (which is now known as Ministry of Education) regarding implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) for admission in Central Educational Institutions.

However, due to administrative/logistic reasons, a different city can be allotted.

PART II (B): Uploading of scanned images

- (i) Candidate's Photograph to be uploaded
 - Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. Photograph should cover 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background.
 - Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly.
 - Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable.
 - Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.
 - Candidates may please note that if it is found that photograph uploaded is fabricated i.e. de- shaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly.
 - Application without photograph shall be rejected. The photograph need not be attested. Candidates are advised to take 6 to 8 passport size coloured photographs with white background.

Note: Passport size photograph is to be used for uploading on Online Application Form and also for pasting on Attendance Sheet at the Examination centre.

• The candidate should scan his/her passport size photograph for uploading. File size must be between 10 kb to 200 kb.

(ii) Candidate's Signature: to be uploaded

The candidates are required to upload the full signature in **running hand** writing in the appropriate box given in the Online Application Form. Writing full name in the Box in Capital letters would not be accepted as signature and the Application Form would be rejected. Further, unsigned Online Application Forms will also be rejected.

- The candidate should put his full signature on white paper with Blue/Black lnk pen and scan for uploading.
- File size must be between 04kb to 30kb.

Note: Candidate must ensure that the uploaded images are clear and proper.

10.7 Check List for filling the Online Application Form:

The candidates are advised to ensure the following points before filling the Online Application Forms:

- (i) Whether they fulfill the eligibility conditions for the Test as prescribed under the heading 'Conditions of Eligibility'.
- (ii) That they have filled their gender and category viz General/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/SC/ ST/Gen-EWS/ Male/Female/Third gender, in the relevant column correctly.

- (iv) That the Person with Disability(PwD) candidate has filled the relevant column in the Online Application Form. Only PwD candidates have to fill this column and the others have to leave it blank.
- (v) Whether they have kept a Printout of Application Form (confirmation page) for their own record.

10.8 Important Points to Note:

- (i) The Candidates should fill their complete postal address with PIN Code for further correspondence.

The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to their satisfying the eligibility conditions.

The candidate has to download the Admit Card from the NTA website and appear for the Examination at the given Centre on Date and timing as indicated in their Admit Card.

No candidate will be allowed to appear at the Examination centre, on Date and timing other than that allotted to them in their Admit Card.

In case of any discrepancy in the particulars of the candidate or his/her photograph and signatures shown in the Admit Card and Confirmation Page, the candidate may immediately approach the Help Line between 10:00 am to 5:00 pm. In such cases, candidates would appear in the Examination with the already downloaded Admit Card. However, NTA will take necessary action to make correction in the record later.

Note:

- a. Candidate may please note that Admit Cards will not be sent by post.
- b. In no case, the duplicate Admit Card for NTET-2024 would be Issued at the Examination Centres.
- c. Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- d. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Cards in good condition for future reference.
- e. No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose Applications are found to be in complete for any reasons (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs/unsigned Applications) or who do not fulfil the eligibility criteria for the examination.

- a. Candidates MUST bring the following documents on the day of Examination at the test centre. Candidates who will not bring these will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
 - i. Print copy of Admit Card downloaded from NTA website
 - ii. One passport size photograph (same as uploaded on the Online Application Form) for pasting on the specific space in the attendance sheet at the Centre during the Examination
 - iii. Anyone of the authorized Govt. photo IDs (original, valid and non-expired), viz. PAN card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ Aadhaar Enrolment No/ Ration Card
 - iv. PwD certificate issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming the relaxation under PwD category.

If the name has been changed due to events such as marriage, candidate must show the relevant document at the time of exam. Marriage Certificate / Divorce / Decree / Legal Name Change Document.

- b. The candidates shall report at the Examination Centre **two hours before the commencement of the Examination** so as to complete the registration formalities well before the time of exam.
- c. Registration desk will close 90 minutes prior to the examination.

- d. The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully and follow them strictly.
- e. Candidates should take their seat immediately after opening of the Examination Hall on their allotted seat. If not, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the Examination Rooms/Halls. The NTA shall not be responsible for any delay.
